

Official Standard of the Afghan Hound

General Appearance—The Afghan Hound is an aristocrat, his whole appearance one of dignity and aloofness with no trace of plainness or coarseness. He has a straight front, proubly carried head, eyes gazing into the distance as if in memory of ages past. The striking characteristics of the breed—exotic, or "Eastern", expression; long silky topknot, peculiar coat pattern, very prominent hipbones, large feet, and the impression of a somewhat exaggerated bend in the stifle due to profuse trouserings—standout clearly, giving the Afghan Hound the appearance of what he is, a king of dogs, that has held true to tradition throughout the ages.

Faults--Coarseness: snippiness: overshot or The ears are long, set approximately on level with the outer corners of the

Neck--The neck is of good length, strong and arched, running in a curve to the shoulders which are long and sloping and well laid back. Faults--Neck too short or too thick: a ewe neck: a goose neck: a neck lacking in substance

Body--The back line appearing practically level from the shoulders to the loin. Strong and powerful loin and slightly arched, falling away toward the stern, with the hipbones very pronounced: well ribbed and tucked up in the flanks. The height at the shoulders equals the distance from the chest to the buttocks; the brisket well let down, and of medium width. Faults--Roach back, swayback, goose rump, slack loin, lack of prominence of hipbones; too much width of brisket, causing interference with elbows.

Tail.-Tail set not too high on the body, having a ring, or a curve on the end; should never be curled over, or rest on the back, or be carried sideways: and should never be bushy.

Legs--Forclegs are straight and strong with great length between elbow and pastern: elbows well held in: forefeet large in both length and widh: toes well arched: feet covered with long thick hair, fine in texture: pasterns long and straight; pads of feet unusually large and well down on the ground. Shoulders have plenty of angulation so that the legs are well set underneath the dog. Too much straightness of shoulder causes the dog to break down in the pasterns, and this is a serious fault. All four feet of the Afghan Hound are in line with the body, turning neither in nor out. The himd feet are broad and of good length: the toes arched, and covered with long thick hair: hindquarters powerful and well muscled, with great length between hip and hock; hocks are well let down; good angulation of both stifle and hock; slightly bowed from hock to crotch. Faults--Front or back feet thrown outward or inward: pads of feet not thick enough; or feet too small; or any other evidence of weakness in feet; weak or broken-down pasterns; too straight in stifle; to long in hock.

Coat--Hindquarters, flanks, ribs, forequarters, and legs well covered with thick, silky hair, very fine in texture: ears and all four feet well feathered; from in front of the shoulders and also backwards from the shoulders along the saddle from the flanks and the ribs upward, the hair is short and close, forming a smooth back in mature dogs-this is a traditional characteristic of the Afghan Hound. The Afghan Hound should be shown in its natural state; the coat is not clipped or trimmed; the head is surmounted (in the full sense of the word) with a topknot of long silky hair-that is also an outstanding characteristic of the Afghan Hound. Showing of short hair on cuffs on either front or back legs is permissible. Fault--Lack of short-haired saddle in mature dogs.

Height--Dogs. 27 inches, plus or minus one inch: bitches. 25 inches, plus or minus one inch.

 ${\sf W}$ eight--Dogs, about 60 pounds; bitches, about 50 pounds.

Color--All colors are permissible, but color or color combinations are pleasing: white markings, especially on the head, are undesirable.

Gait--When running free, the Afghan Hound moves at a gallop, showing great elasticity and spring in his smooth, powerful stribe. When on a loose lead, the Afghan can trot at a fast pace: stepping along, he has the appearance of placing the hind feet directly in the foot prints of the front feet, both thrown straight ahead. Moving with head and tail high, the whole appearance of the Afghan Hound is one of great style and beauty.

l emperament--Aloof and dignified, yet gay. Faults--Sharpness or shyness.

"Iffy" was stubborn and very hard headed, like no other from this dog. Even though the Jensens tried to convince me to consider a living with such a gorgeous creature. I felt sure. would be all I would want my spare time I danced competitively. I always loved animals, so just platform work, competed in hair shows, and owned my own business. In was a hair dresser, studied under Vidal Sassoon, performed and taught figured my attachment was because I had this hair fetish. At the time, I fell in love with their asthetic beauty. flowing gait, and glamorous coat. I I purchased my first Afghan from the famed Pamir kennels in 1968, and at

It wasn't until 1975 that I got my first real show Afghan. Isfahan's Silver Gobspell. from Frank and Robin Vasquz. Unfortunately. "Gobspell" bied of bloat before he finished, but he was a wonderful dog, noted for his great movement. Also, around this time, I bought my first Whippet. My Whippets have gone on to do a lot of winning and have set some wonderful records. In the late 70s, I finished my first Afghan, Ch. Summerwind Sacre' Bleu Mist. Then, shortly after, finished SBIS Ch. Summerwind Hard Act to Follow, both handled by Warron Cook.

In 1980. I met my husband Bruce, fell in love, and we both totally went to the dogs. We formed Summerwinds BIS Inc. a product and market development company in the pet industry. Both Bruce and I became professional handlers. handling and campaigning many of this country's finiest dogs in Afghans. Whippets, Greyhounds, Borzois, Irish Wolfhounds, Salukis, etc. Between Bruce and I. I don't know how many champions we've finished for others, but it's been too many to remember.

At his point, we have bred and owned well over 100 AKC champions, plus many other champions in many other countries. We've owned and handled the number one Whippet in 1994--Ch. Snowy Creek Best Bet of Bohem, the number one Afghan and number three Afghan--SBIS Ch. Naphtali's Caleb Caldea, and the number two male and number six Afghan--BIS Ch. Paladin the Darkman V Isameh--all in the same year.

This year I am handling and campaigning the beautiful BIS Ch. Palabin the Darkman V Isameh again for his new owner Windermere, and breeder/co-owners Michael Liss. Bruce and I.

I feel very honored to be asked to judge sweeps at the Potomac Afghan Hound Club, and look forward to seeing some future stars. Thank you.







Introducing: The Regular Classes Judge

Ms. Patricia lbe

My first experience in show bogs was primarily with Afghan Hounds. We showed and bred Afghans under the "Huzzah" prefix. After about fifteen years in the breed, we obtained our first Greyhound which soon multiplied into many more, rivaling the Afghans in number. Since the Greyhound was easier to maintain, and there was far less competition and preparation at shows, we gradually phased out the Afghans through attrition. Combining numbers from both breeds, we have bred more than 100 champions, including BIS and group winners, as well as nine specialty BIS winners. We have babbled in several other sight hound breeds and now have a few Cavaliers. However, there will always be a special place in my heart for the Afghan. This breed has a certain charm no other breed possesses and, once experienced, is not soon forgotten.

My judging experience began with assignments in England. Australia and Mexico, before I had applied to judge here in the States. I had sent two Afghans overseas, Am.Eng. Ch. Huzzah Excelsis to England and Am. Aust. Ch. Huzzah Jack Frost to Australia. Both were quite successful in their new homes which. I'm sure, prompted the judging assignments.

Presently, I am approved to judge the Hound Group and Italian Greyhounds. I have judged in most states and in England, Australia, Canada, Finland. Sweden and Norway. I have seen Afghans in many places and am most impressed with the fashion in which the worldwide breeders cooperate with one another. This is probably the main reason the breed is in such fine condition today.

I am truly delighted to have been invited to judge this specialty and I wish you all as much enjoyment from the day as I expect to have.


