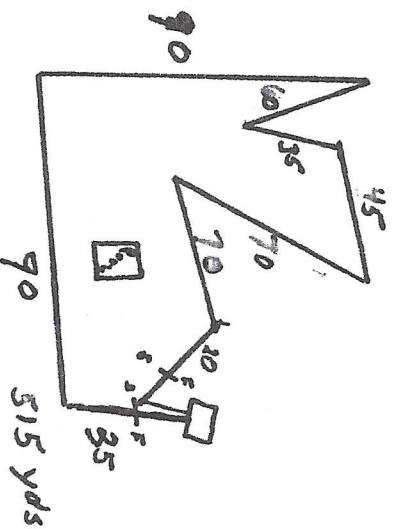

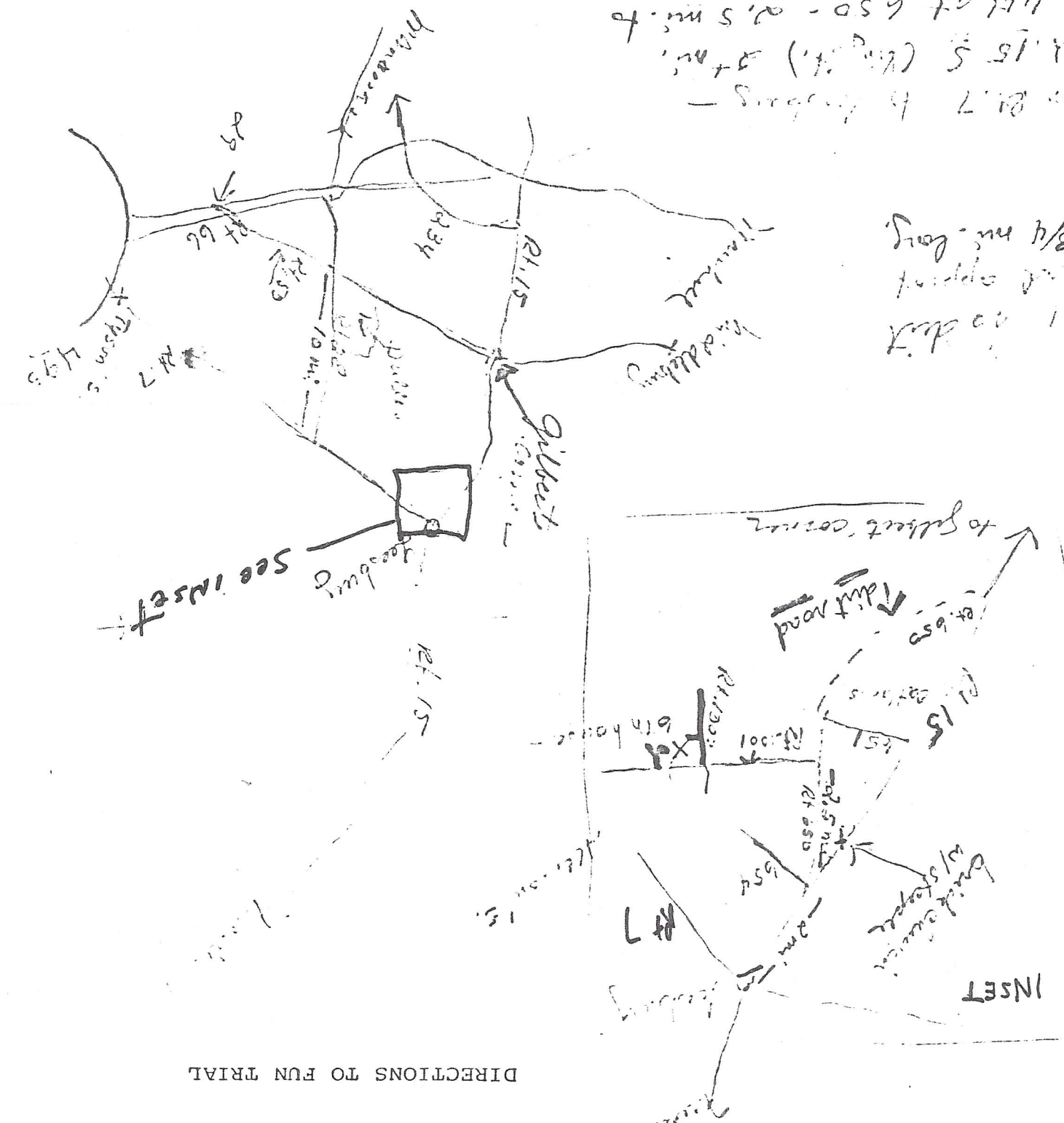
- 1) Hounds must be one year or older on the day of the trial.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
