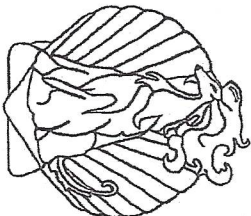

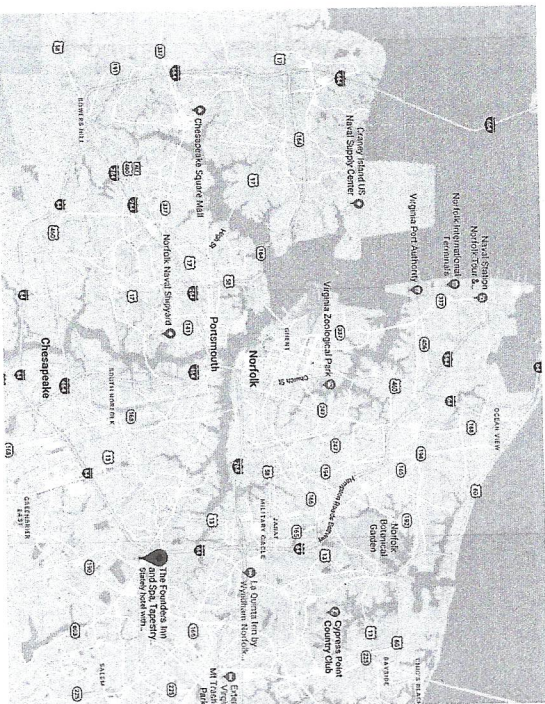

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Best puppy: Open to the dogs and bitches placing first in the regular puppy classes. **No additional entry fee is required.**

Best Breed-by-Exhibitor: Open to the dogs and bitches placing first in the Breed-by-Exhibitor classes. **No additional entry fee is required.**

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries) - Richmond & Carolina ONLY - NOT TIDEWATER

STUD DOG CLASS will be for Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Only the Get will be judged based on their merits. If the dogs (Stud Dog & Get) are entered in Regular Classes, this class shall be considered a single additional entry and the entry fee will be \$30.00. If the dogs (Stud Dogs and Get) are NOT entered in Regular Classes, then each must be entered as an individual entry and the entry fee for each shall be \$30.00.

BROOD BITCH CLASS will be for Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. Owner of Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of Produce. Only the Produce will be judged based on their merits. If the dogs (Brood Bitch & Produce) are entered in Regular Classes, this class shall be considered a single additional entry and the entry fee will be \$30.00. If the dogs (Brood Bitch and Produce) are NOT entered in Regular Classes, then each must be entered as an individual entry and the entry fee for each shall be \$30.00.

ENTRY FEE: See Page 3 for entry fees. **CLOSING DATE** for entries 12:00 NOON, Wednesday, OCTOBER 9, 2019 (at Show Secretary's Office) after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. **THESE SHOWS** will be open from 7:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. **AKC RECORDING FEE** of \$5.00 and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show. It a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee and Service Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2). All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. **RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$20.00 will be made for each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. An administrative Fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE and UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED. ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS AND PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

The person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission and identification before the dog will be received. **SHOULD SUCH ACKNOWLEDGEMENT NOT BE RECEIVED BY THE EXHIBITOR** within a reasonable time, please notify Jim Rau Dog Shows at (610) 376-1880.

MAKE ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO Rau Dog Shows, Ltd. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Superintendent assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. **ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO Rau Dog Shows, Ltd. are processed through the FAX program and will be charged a \$4.00 per dog per show processing fee.**

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS. **NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.**

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING. **DOGS MAY ARRIVE** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the Superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

THE SHOW COMMITTEE/SUPERINTENDENT will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

CANINE COURTESY All dogs shall be kept under control at all times. You are responsible for picking up after the animals in your care.

To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Refund and Cash award checks are void after 180 days and will NOT be re-issued. An administrative fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
